Our Show offers all mineral and fossil collectors, goldsmiths, jewellery designers, jewelers, museums, specialist dealers, representatives of associated professional fields and suppliers of accessories the opportunity to engage in comprehensive sharing of information, purchasing, sales and exchange.

# 1. To become a exhibitor on Scottish Mineral, Fossil and Jewellery Show:

You must register yourself, by completing the application form and making sure to name the products and pay required deposit. By registering, you commit to abide by the terms and conditions of the Show. Please email your signed form to: CaledonianRockShop@gmail.com

A service fee of 3 % is charged if payment is made by Internet-based means of payment (PayPal) or credit card (VISA, MasterCard, American Express).

Booking won't be accepted without completed application form and correct deposit paid by 16th of February 2020. If your application has been accepted, you will receive confirmation email.

Deposit is non-refundable, with exception of rejected applications.

Outstanding balance will be collected in CASH on the first day of the Show.

Prices stated are for whole weekend - regardless if you choose to attend both days or Saturday only.

## 2.During the exhibition, you can sell:

Minerals, fossils, uncut stones, uncut gemstones, meteorites, gemstones, semi-precious stones, cut collectors' stones, jewellery with stones, necklaces & strands, unique and design jewellery with genuine stones, jewellery accessories, advertising and gift items made of stone, mollusc shells, mussels, coral, machines, geo-devices, specialist literature and collectors' items. Reference is made to adherence to the regulations governing the protection of endangered species and that any required marketing papers must be kept on hand for presentation.

All goods must be labeled with name, place of discovery and retail price, incl. VAT in GBP. The designations "fair price", "fair discount" or "sale", are not permitted. Items not for sale or items that are already sold must be labeled especially as such; the same applies to synthetic or irradiated minerals, repaired specimen or fossil reproductions.

Only goods stated by you in reservation form, are allowed to be sold during the Show.

Hazardous/radioactive minerals should be clearly marked and kept out of reach of children at all times.

## 3. Tables and display

The tabletop (attention: risk of tilting, ensure stability and robustness!) is 182x76 cm. A suitable table cover and front and back paneling to the floor (suspended cloth) are considered to be a minimum contribution to a proper exhibition appearance. Decorative tabletop structures are welcome.

The exhibitor will ensure sufficient lighting and will adhere strictly to the PAT testing regulations; exhibitor must provide own multiple power sockets and extension cords. Electricity usage is restricted to 600 watts per table. Kettles are not allowed.

## 4. Security, guarding

The SMFJS will handle the general security of the exhibition halls and the adjacent grounds, but will not accept liability for loss or damage.

Instructions issued by the security staff, in particular with regard to the obligation to wear ID, must on all accounts be followed. The exhibitors must guard their own exhibition booths and merchandise during the opening hours and during the times of set-up and dismantling. It is not permitted to stay overnight. SMFJS cannot be held responsible for damage or loss of stock' however caused. Stands might be left erected overnight, but this is no way implies responsibility on the part of the organisers for loss or damage. All exhibitors should have their own Insurance.

#### 5. Liability

The exhibitors are liable for all personal or material damage they cause, or caused by their employees, representatives or their exhibition objects and fixtures. They are obligated to fit required safety features to the devices they exhibit. Scottish Mineral, Fossil and Jewellery Show will accept no liability whatsoever on any grounds, in particular for damage to and loss of the exhibition objects, the booth fixtures or for consequent damage, unless the damage was caused by gross negligence or culpable intent on the part of the legal representatives of SMFJS, its employees or assistants. This applies in equal measure to direct claims against the aforementioned group of persons. SMFJS is therefore only liable for material and personal damage for which it can be made liable in accordance with statutory provisions. In the event that in these terms and conditions, SMFJS has provided for regulations as concerns restrictions on liability, exclusions of liability, limitation periods and statutes of limitations, they shall, in the event that blame lies with SMFJS, not apply to the violation of essential contractual obligations, intentional or grossly negligent actions and not for damages arising from injury to life, limb and health. All exhibitors should carry their own Public Liability Insurance.

#### 6. Customs and fiscal measures

Each exhibitor is responsible for their own customs and tax obligations.

# 7. Rules of conduct during the exhibition

Exhibitors are required to set up fully their stands by 9:45 am on each day.

It is prohibited to disassemble your stand or table before the closing time of the show.

The Show opening times are 10am – to 5pm, Saturday and Sunday.

Time dedicated to equipping exhibitors' stands and tables: Friday - 3-8pm Saturday - 7 - 9.30am

Sunday - 8 - 9.30am

Participants who wish to equip their stands and tables on Friday, are required to contact the organisers no later than 1 week prior the Show.

In case of any delays, please contact the organisers.

If the tables or stands won't be occupied until the public opening of the exhibition, they will be deemed cancelled (no refunds), however they can be assigned to the waiting list, if there is a prior notice of the delay.

Exhibitors who make reservations and are not present at the event (except for a prior cancellation, communicated to the organisers) might not be accepted to the future events.

Abandoning the usage of proper table or stand does not provide the return of the rights to use it.

To get a designated area, the exhibitor must comply with the rules of payment.

#### 8. Prohibitions

- It is forbidden to transfer (also on a free basis), change (without the consent of the organizators) the reserved areas.
- It is not allowed to interfere with or to occupy the areas larger than your own.
- Advertising in any form is not permitted outside your allocated area.
- It is not allowed to drill, hammer or hang displays or advertisment on the walls.
- Demonstrations and tests, which could jeopardize the safety of people are forbidden, as well as turning on any machines without the written consent of the organisators.
- It is prohibited to disassemble your stand or table before the closing of the exhibition.
- Kettle use during show is not allowed.
- Smoking or vaping is not allowed inside the building of the Show.

#### 9. Final notes

- Car park access is free to public and exhibitors.
- Admission to the Show is free for general public.
- The show will take place on the first floor. There is no access to the lift.
- The show is hosted inside the building, however with no heating. We advise to wear suitable clothing.

## 10. Storage of data

The exhibitor explicitly declares consent that Scottish Mineral, Fossil and Jewellery Show will store, process or transmit personal data within the scope of the data protection act, provided this is necessitated for exclusively commercial reasons.
